Evaluator Training

- Teacher Evaluation Training
 - All evaluators receive initial training from 5D+ Center for Educational Leadership's Teacher Evaluation System through Michigan Association of Secondary School Principals or an expert trainer.
 - Additional training related to inter-rater reliability will occur every third year. The initial training was August 13, 2024 provided by an expert trainer in a joint session with administrators from Allendale Public Schools.
- Administrator Evaluation Training
 - Initial training was provided by Michigan Association of Superintendents and Administrators (MASA) on the School ADvance Rubric. Most recently, administrators were trained on version 3.0.
 - Board of Education members were initially trained as a whole on the Michigan Association of School Board's Superintendent Evaluation process. The Board is committed to a "train the trainer" model via the President and Vice President as new members join.

Educator Training

- The Coopersville District Leadership Team provides training on the evaluation tool and process annually during professional development time. The first training under new laws took place August 20, 2024.

Future Training

- Training will continue on an annual basis or as prescribed by law.
